

## OHC COVID-19 OPERATIONS MODIFICATIONS

*UPDATED MARCH 24, 2020*

1. OHC, INC is closely monitoring the guidelines and response to the COVID-19 pandemic. As the health of your workers is our primary concern, OHC, INC has changed our operations to support this National and State of Emergency with the following modifications:
  - a. Our Mount Vernon Clinic, which is co-located with the Mobile County Health Department, has temporarily relocated to the Michigan Avenue location due to the temporary closure of the Mobile County Health Department.
  - b. We are prescreening everyone prior to entering the building and we are limiting the number of clients/patients allowed in the waiting areas to comply with “social distancing.” Only clients/patients and company representatives or case managers may enter. No children or guests will be allowed in the waiting areas.
  - c. Any clients/patients who potentially screened positive for possible COVID-19 infection will be directed to self-isolate or follow up with their primary care provider. Self-isolation should remain in effect until they are fever and symptom free unless they are a work compensation patient. We have a responsibility to assess and continue the treatment of the work compensation patient.
  - d. We are presently suspending pulmonary function testing and limiting breath alcohol testing (BAT) to return to duty, for cause, and post-accident evaluation. Routine and random BAT will not be performed.
2. We will continue to provide regulatory examinations (DOT, Merchant Marine, FAA, Annual Surveillance, and Respiratory Protection clearances) and company specific physicals (Fit for Duty and Preplacement Examinations) with the above restrictions.
